**DAY 1 BISMARCK, ND:** Saddle up for western adventure complete with bulls, spirited horses and dare devil cowboys. We're on our way to the Centennial year of the "Greatest Outdoor Show on Earth," the Calgary Stampede. This morning we enjoy coffee & rolls as we head to North Dakota for a welcome dinner and an overnight in Bismarck at the Ramkota Inn.(CR, D)

**DAY 2 LEWISTON, MT:** A morning stop in Medora, ND and a visit Theodore Roosevelt National Park is on our agenda today. Then it's on to Lewiston, MT for our overnight at the Yogo Inn.

**DAY 3 HIGH RIVER, AB:** Breakfast is included this morning. We make a stop at the Charles Russell Museum in Great Falls before we cross the border into Canada. We'll travel to Fort Macleod, the first headquarters of the Northwest Mounted Police. We'll stop at Head-smashed in Buffalo Interpretive Center. This seven story center is built into a cliff showing the lifestyle & history of the tribes that inhabited this area. Check into our hotel, the Heritage Inn. (B)

**DAY 4 CALGARY:** "Stampede fever" takes over as this ten-day celebration of the west begins. We attend the gala parade as the stampede kicks off. This evening we attend one of Stampede highlights, the World Championship chuckwagon races. In this unique event, drivers and four-horse teams race to the finish line in an amazing display of horsepower and nerve. When the sun goes down we attend a spectacular stage show featuring hundreds of singers, dancers and musicians capped off by a firework finale. We'll enjoy an included dinner and check in for 2 nights at the Best Western Village Park Inn. (D)

**DAY 5 CALGARY:** Today we spend a full day in the breathtaking scenery of the Canadian Rockies. We start off our day with a visit to Banff National Park and the beautiful blue green Glacier waters of Lake Louise. Lunch will be at the world famous Chateau Lake Louise. Our next stop will be the town of Banff for free time to roam and shop this quaint resort town. (B, L)

**DAY 6 BROOKS, AB:** This morning breakfast is included before we head back to the Stampede Grounds. This afternoon we attend the Calgary Stampede "Half Million Dollar Rodeo" where the top professional cowboys in the world meet the challenge of rodeo stock bred just for competition. Events include saddle bronc and bareback riding, steer wrestling and barrel racing. We'll depart for Brooks, Alberta checking into our hotel the Heritage Inn & Suites. (B)

**DAY 7 REGINA, SASKATCHEWAN:** This morning we'll travel east to Regina, Saskatchewan and visit the Royal Canadian Mounted Police Museum prior to checking into our hotel, the Wingate Inn. (B).

**DAY 8 DEVILS LAKE, ND:** We travel south today to the International Peace Gardens, on the border of Manitoba and North Dakota. This park is set among the lakes and streams of the Turtle Mountains, commemorating the friendship between Canada and the USA. A step on guide will show us the sights, along with an included lunch. We motor to Devils Lake North Dakota, overnight at the Spirit Mountain Resort and Casino. (L)

**DAY 9 TWIN CITIES:** The beauty of the Canadian Rockies and excitement of the stampede are in our thoughts as we return home today. Early evening return to the Twin Cities.

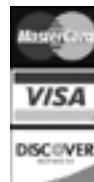
