In Fall 2011 the Wild West returns to Custer State Park during the 47th annual Buffalo Roundup. It's a crisp September morning and the dew glistens on the grasses. A low rumble gets louder and louder, and suddenly hundreds of bison stampede over a hilltop with cowboy and cowgirl wranglers moving the park's 1500 bison! Top this off with the 1880 Train, one of America's last steam trains in service, Mount Rushmore and Crazy Horse Memorial, up close and personal.

"Tours You're Going to Love!"

Day 1: Our first stop is for coffee and rolls as we head into South Dakota. We'll continue west stopping for lunch (on our own.) followed by the famous Corn Palace before we overnigh at Al's Oasis in Chamberlain, South Dakota. (CR)

Day 2: Continental breakfast is included this morning before we continue our journey west. We'll arrive in Hill City just in time to Board the 1880's Train, one of America's last steam trains still in service. We'll take the route that the early miners and pioneers used to explore the Black Hills. This train was featured in the Gunsmoke series, the Orphan Train and Into the West. Arrival in historical Keystone in time to do some browsing and exploring, not to mention shopping. Our coach will meet us and return to Hill City to check into our home for the next (3) nights, the Best Western Golden Spike. Evening is free and dinner is on own. CB

Day 3: Full, hot breakfast is included this morning before we head to Custer Park for the Buffalo Roundup Arts Festival activities. Enjoy South Dakota's finest artists and craftsmen and on-going Western and Native American entertainment. We'll stop at the Crazy Horse Memorial and meet our step-on guide for an "up close and personal" ride to the base of the mountain. Next is Mount Rushmore with time to view the Monument and dinner is included. Return to our hotel for the evening in Hill City.. (CB, D)

Day 4: Early morning departure to the 45th annual "Buffalo Roundup Day." We'll have special bus parking and public viewing of the stampeding buffalo, as the wranglers ride and guide them into special corrals. Bring your cameras and binoculars. Lunch is included at the roundup. Do some last minute shopping, and check out the buffalo corrals as the wranglers sort and brand the herd. This evening we head to Fort Hays for a chuckwagon supper and music show. A menu to tempt your western palate is served on tin plates and tin cups. The Fort Hays Wranglers will entertain with comedy and a popular western music variety show. You will have a foot stompin', belly shakin' good time! There will be time to wander through the original set from the movie "Dances with Wolves" before we depart for our hotel. (CB, L, D)

Day 5: Breakfast is included before we depart Hill City. We'll stop at Wall Drug for lunch (on own). We'll explore the Badlands as we travel the famous Badlands Loop. Then it's on to Chamberlain SD for our overnigh. (CB)

Day 6: Homeward bound! We'll stop at the Akta Lakota Indian School and Museum before departing for home. There will be appropriate stops enroute. (CB)

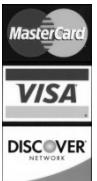
