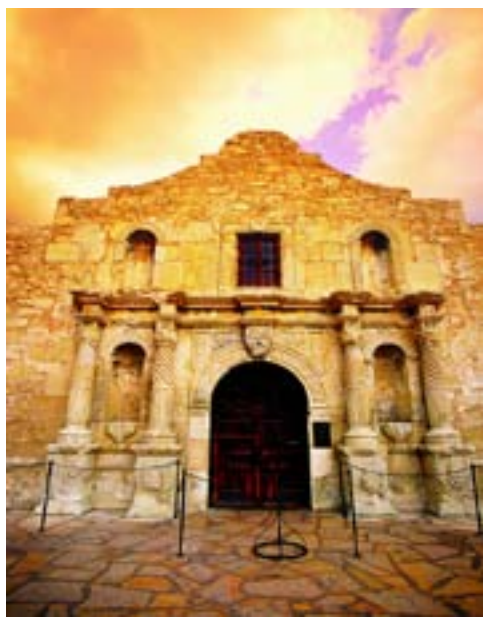


# TEXAS

**DAY 1** Shawnee Mission, KS: Today we'll get acquainted with our fellow travelers as we stop for yummy coffee and cinnamon rolls. Lunch (on own) will be in Des Moines as we continue our journey into Kansas, overnighing at the Drury Inn & Suites. Dinner (on own) tonight, managers reception between 5:30-7p. (CR)

**DAY 2** Norman, OK: A quick start hot breakfast is included this morning. Our travels take us through the "Show Me" State of Missouri, to Oklahoma City. The National Cowboy Heritage Museum is on our activity agenda this afternoon. This memorial to our Western pioneers has a wonderful collection of historic artifacts and American Indian & Pioneer exhibits, along with an 18 foot statue of the "End of the Trail". Our overnight is at the Country Inn & Suites in Norman OK. (B)

**DAY 3** Austin, TX: The capital city of Austin is our destination, over nighting at the Drury Inn & Suites. (CB)

It all starts with the river. San Antonio's one-of-a-kind River Walk is the lifeline of this charming city – it anchors a vibrant downtown that sits in the very heart of South Texas. It flows past lively restaurants and clubs, world class hotels and spas, historic villages, museums and of course, near the Alamo. Beyond its banks you'll find an exciting mix of diverse cultures, attractions and recreation stretching into the breathtaking Texas Hill Country.

**DAY 4** Our adventure starts "Deep in the Heart of Texas". We'll take in some of the sights of Austin before we depart to San Antonio. We'll check into the beautiful Drury Inn & Suites on the River walk for the next 3 nights. This evening is free to explore the Riverwalk, with River Barge vouchers included. (B, L)

**DAY 5** San Antonio, TX: Today, we head into the Hill Country of Texas. Here, in the heart of budding wildflowers and bluebonnets, is a part of Texas that is used for a favorite retreat since pioneer days. We'll stop in the towns of Bandera, Kerrville and Fredericksburg. Lunch will be included today. Early return to San Antonio so you have free time to enjoy the Riverwalk. (B,L)

**DAY 6** San Antonio, TX : We'll enjoy a City tour this morning including the historical Mission Trail. Free time has been arranged so you can explore at your leisure. This evening we'll enjoy a performance of the San Antonio Rose at the Aztec Theater. (B)

**DAY 7** Sherman, TX: Farewell to San Antonio as we head north toward home. We'll stop in Dallas to visit the Sixth Floor Museum John F. Kennedy Memorial. Our next stop is the Southfork Ranch in Plano TX. We'll tour the famous Ewing Ranch house and grounds. Dinner included this evening. Check into the Hampton Inn, Sherman TX. (B, D)

**DAY 8** Shawnee Mission, KS: A continental breakfast is included this morning before we depart north traveling thru Texas and Oklahoma into Kansas, overnight at the Drury Inn & Suites. Farewell Dinner included tonight. (CB, D)

**DAY 9** Twin Cities: Homeward bound today. Appropriate stops enroute. Early evening arrival in the Twin Cities. (B)
